Take the **PSAT 10** test

When should I take it?

- Take the **PSAT 10** test spring of your **Sophomore** year.
- You can take the **ACT** test anytime your **Junior** year or Fall of your **Senior** year.

How is the ACT test scored?

- There are five sections to the test:
- English, Math, Reading, Science & Writing (optional)
- Each section is worth 25% of your score (writing is additional)

Any Tips?

Make sure to **answer every question!** Points aren't taken away if you guess and get it wrong.

- **Cal Poly** prefers the **ACT** Test.

How much does it cost?

Test includes 4 score reports

- **ACT** (No Writing) \$49.50
- **ACT** Plus Writing \$58.50

When should I take it?

- Take the **PSAT** test fall of your **Junior** year.
- You can take the **SAT** Test anytime your **Junior** year of Fall or your **Senior** year until December.

How is the SAT test scored?

- There are three sections to the test:
- Reading, Math, and Writing & Language
- Essay is optional
- Each section is worth 50% of your score

Any Tips?

- **SCORED** out of a total score of 1600.
- Guess if you need to!

- With **ESSAY** \$60.00
