SENIORS WILL BE NOTIFIED of their LIFE TIME STATUS (gold cord) in May

A. To qualify for CSF membership this trimester, follow these guidelines:

1. You must earn a **minimum of 10 points** from last trimester's grades.
 - a. The first 4 points must be from LIST I (unless you are a senior applying for membership in February or June).
 - b. The first 7 points (including the four points described in a) must be from LISTS I and II.
 - c. The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II or III).
2. You must use *no more than 5 courses* to qualify.
3. No CSF points are given for PE or Athletic participation or subjects repeated to improve a grade.
4. CSF points are granted as follows:
 - a. **Grade of A = 3 CSF points** **Grade of B = 1 CSF point** **Grade of C = 0 CSF points**
 - b. One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP or Honors class, up to a maximum of 2 pts.
 - c. *A grade of D or F in any class, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership.*
 - D. Concurrent enrollment college courses are treated like a core class with no extra weight.

B. Please note:

Trimester membership is based on work completed in the *previous* trimester. You must reapply *each trimester*.
 Courses you may use are listed on the reverse side. They are divided into LISTS I, II, and III.

CALIFORNIA SCHOLARSHIP FEDERATION

The California Scholarship Federation (CSF) is a statewide scholarship society founded in 1921 to recognize academic achievement.

Membership is *NOT* automatic. All eligible students must apply during the enrollment period. The enrollment period is the first two weeks of each trimester.

The goal of every CSF member is to be designated a seal bearer/life member. A seal bearer can receive a gold seal on their diploma, and wear the CSF gold cords at graduation. In order to earn this honor, a student must be eligible and apply for membership six (6) out of the last nine (9) Trimesters; one of the nine (9) Trimesters must be from the senior year (the grades from the 9th Grade do not count).
