

# CALIFORNIA SCHOLARSHIP FEDERATION

The California Scholarship Federation (CSF) is a statewide scholarship society founded in 1921 to recognize academic achievement. *Membership is NOT automatic.* All eligible students must apply during the enrollment period. The enrollment period is the first two weeks of each trimester. The goal of every CSF member is to be designated a seal bearer/life member. A seal bearer can receive a gold seal on their diploma, and wear the CSF gold cords at graduation. In order to earn this honor, a student must be eligible and apply for membership six (6) out of the last nine (9) Trimesters; one of the nine (9) Trimesters must be from the senior year (the grades from the 9th Grade do not count).
