***The Employee Resource Groups at PG&E will reward college-bound students for their academic achievements & community service who reside in a P G & E service area.***

*To apply for a PG&E Scholarship, students need to complete basic scholarship application & supplemental application to a specific Employee Resource Group.*

◆ **The Access Network Employee Resource Group**

The purpose of the Access Network Employee Resource Group are to support, advocate for, and celebrate the inclusion of people with disabilities in PG&E's workforce; to provide support to the community with disabilities. They will award 5 or more \$3,000 scholarships.

◆ **The Asian Employee Resource Group**

will be awarding at least 10 scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 to \$2,000 each.

◆ **The Black Employee Resource Group**

10 or more deserving students will receive a scholarship in amounts from \$1,000 to \$5,000

◆ **The Latino Employee Resource Group**

is awarding 30 scholarships in amounts ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,000 to seniors.

◆ **The Legacy Employee Resource Group**

strives to share the experience, knowledge and perspective brought by employees that have tenure or bring tenure to PG&E. Legacy ERG will award up to \$3,000 to at least 5 recipients.

◆ **Pacific Service Employees Association**

PSEA will award \$1,000 to 17 PG&E employee dependents.

◆ **The Pride Network Employee Resource Group**

Awards \$6,000 scholarships to at least 5 students for their service to the gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender community.

◆ **The Samahan ( Filipino) Employee Resource Group**

"Samahan", meaning unity or collaboration in Tagalog, promotes social and educational aspects of Filipino-American culture and heritage Samahan Employee Resource Group will award \$1,000 to \$2,000 in scholarships to at least 10 college-bound high school seniors

◆ **The Veterans Employee Resource Group**

shares a vision of excellence through leadership and to act on behalf of veterans, both within PG&E and the communities we touch. Veterans ERG will award \$5,000 or more in scholarships to five to ten college bound seniors.

◆ **The Women's Network Employee Resource Group**

Women's Network Employee Resource Group mission is to promote, develop, and celebrate the community of women working at PG&E. They are active in many non-profit organizations devoted to professional development, environmental stewardship, and women-focused issues. Women's Network ERG will award \$1,000 to \$3,000 in scholarships to at least 5 seniors.
