

SLOHS REGISTRATION TOP 10 MOST FAQs

1. HOW MANY CLASSES DO I NEED TO REGISTER FOR?

You must select 15 courses and 4 alternates before you submit. Be sure to **read & follow the directions for each line**. If you cannot find the course you need, please write it on your printed requests.

2. I'D LIKE TO MEET WITH YOU TO TALK ABOUT WHAT CLASSES TO TAKE NEXT YEAR...

Counselors will be available to meet with students who have questions about their course selections in April and May. Please enter your courses into PowerSchool **NO LATER than Friday, March 23rd at 4pm**. You will be able to discuss/change your requests with your counselor through the end of the school year.

3. I NEED TO SIGN UP FOR SUMMER SCHOOL

Summer School applications will open in April, please sign up to see your Counselor in April.

4. I WANT TO TAKE A CLASS AT CUESTA THIS SUMMER

Cuesta's Summer 2018 application and schedule will be available online the first week of April. Directions concerning the steps to take are available on the Counseling webpage. (taking a class at Hancock this summer? -same answer)

5. IF I'M PLANNING TO TAKE A CLASS THIS SUMMER, WHAT SHOULD I SIGN UP FOR NOW IN POWERSCHOOL?

Please be sure to sign up for all the classes you need for next year. Once you have completed your summer course work we can adjust your course requests.

6. I CAN'T ENTER THE COURSE I WANT TO TAKE ON THE POWERSCHOOL LINE PROVIDED...

Please enter your courses as accurately as possible. If you cannot find a course on a certain line, please write down the course once you have printed your courses requests.

7. I THINK MY PE CREDITS ARE MESSED UP...WHAT SHOULD I DO?

Don't worry! Athletic credits are hand tabulated at the end of 10th and 11th grades. If your PE credits look incorrect on your transcript, don't worry...just let your Counselor know.

8. I NEED MORE INFO ABOUT A CLASS, I CAN'T DECIDE WHICH CLASSES I WANT TO SIGN UP FOR...
