Take the **PLAN** test, which is the **practice ACT**

When should I take it?

- Take the **PLAN** test fall of your **Sophomore** year.
- You can take the **ACT** test anytime your **Junior** year or Fall of your **Senior** year.

How is the test scored?

- There are five sections to the test: **English**, **Math**, **Reading**, **Science** and **Writing** (optional)
- Each section is worth 25% of your score (writing is additional)

Any Tips?

Make sure to **answer every question!** Points aren't taken away if you guess and get it wrong.

- **Cal Poly** prefers the **ACT** Test.

How much does it cost?

- **ACT** (No Writing) \$34
- **ACT** Plus Writing \$50

- The **PSAT** could qualify you the **National Merit Scholarship**.

When should I take it?

- Take the **PSAT** test fall of your **Junior** year.
- You can take the **SAT** Test anytime your **Junior** year of Fall or your **Senior** year until December.

How is the test scored?

- There are three sections to the test: **Critical Reading**, **Math**, and **Writing** (optional)
- Each section is worth 50% of your score (writing is additional)

Any Tips?

For all multiple choice questions:

- +1 point for a correct answer
- 1/4 point for a wrong answer
- +0 points for leaving it blank
