This chart outlines the SLOHS Graduation Requirements and UC/CSU Minimum Entrance Requirements. Courses used to meet minimum entrance eligibility to The University of California & The California State University systems are known as "a-g" courses, this refers to an approved list of courses that meet entrance requirements. Think about your post high school plans, login into Family Connection and decide which courses you will take in order to meet SLOHS Graduation Requirements and UC/CSU Entrance Requirements by managing your course plans under the Courses Tab.
